Electrical Contractor Training Program (Nominees Modules)



OVERVIEW

In WA, the Electricity (Licensing) Regulations 1991 provide that electrical contracting work may only be carried out by persons holding the appropriate electrical licence as issued by the Electrical Licensing Board.

This Building and Energy approved course satisfies the Electrical Contractor Training Program (ECTP) and provides licensed electricians with the training, skills and knowledge required to identify, investigate and apply statutory and legislative requirements, manage jobs and operate a business and inspect and test electrical installation work according to regulatory requirements.

REQUIREMENTS

Entry to module WAE200 will require applicants to hold a current WA Unrestricted Electrician's Licence. You need to work through the Pre Reading document provided prior to course commencement and complete the associated Practice Activities.
